- Turf Use
 - Revisit the availability of the turf. Dr. O'Donnell presented 3 options:
 - 1 Current access stays as is
 - 2 Open the turf area dawn to dusk each day and permit public use during times when no organized events are taking place
 - 3 Trial Option 2 from the end of school until school begins and then assess. Limited to when school is not in session and no organized events.
 - If Option 2 or 3, there is going to be a slight cost to add a locking mechanism, signage, and panic hardware, etc. estimated at \$2K.
 - Mr. Frey mentioned that the area will not be available for roughly 2 days in July for maintenance/upkeep.

- Dr. O'Donnell has concerns of someone getting hurt if nobody is around, vandalism, leading to conflict with shared time.
- Mr. Decker stated he would like to see the taxpayers have access to the facility, especially with the proposed increase in taxes for the upcoming school year.
- Mr. Hall is concerned about vandalism and/or it costing the taxpayers additional money with Option 2 or 3.
 - Recommendation:
 - Mr. Decker and Mr. Hall agreed on Option 3.
 - Mr. O'Donnell will draft a resolution for the board to review based on the feedback.
- Traffic Flow Update
 - New pattern is going very well. Mr. Baker and Mr. Frey did a good job of communication and no issues to date.

 - Mr. Frey moved forward with the contractor and a walkthrough, ordered products for upgrades, doors, etc.
